Further internal moderation was conducted on various pieces as evidenced in the EPF Assessment Records, on an ongoing basis where CMi sought clarification.

Evidence Rationale

As per WJEC instructions the normal internal assessment and standardisation process was undertaken. All work was completed.

Where sources were limited due to covid restrictions this was judged accordingly when applying the assessment objectives, and annotated in the evidence.

There was no need to adjust for incomplete work, since all work had been completed.
