Unit 2 LO1 & 2 To establish a TAG we have used the student's evidence portfolio where technical drawings for each stage of the practical assessment are interpreted and turned in to a plan of action by the candidate. A clear plan shows the understanding of technical data (LO1) and demonstrates the preparation for the practical task (LO2)

Unit 2 LO3 To establish an overall practical grade we have assessed the 3 main practical skills that all students were able to access despite the challenges of lockdown. Joinery, Wall Tiling & Painting and Decorating. Photographic evidence in the portfolio and teacher observation of live skills make up the assessment of completion of construction tasks (LO3).

Unit 3 LO1 LO2 LO3 We have printed the student presentations to establish learning and understanding for all Unit 3 teaching/learning/materials. Each student prepared a revision guide / presentation which addresses the separate elements of the specification LO1 LO2 & LO3. All students had access to this both at school and off site through google classrooms.

Unit 3 Exam We used the sample assessment materials provided by WJEC for Unit 3 LO1, LO2, LO3. We left out the Numeracy/QS section (task 1) for all students as we couldn't guarantee that they had covered this area sufficiently due to lockdown. This reduced the paper form 60 marks to 45 marks in total and we adjusted time and access requirements for the paper in the usual examination/assessment environment. We set grade boundaries at 100%-80% L2D, 79%-60% L2M, 59%-40% L2P & 39%-20% L1 to establish performance indicators.
